



EQUIPMENT & RELATED SUPPLIES FOR OPERATIONAL PERIODS ★

This is a **suggested** list of equipment & check list to insure that you don't forget any important items you might need in providing effective communication support. This list can also be added to by each person to meet their personal needs.

RADIOS & RELATED EQUIPMENT

- 2m & 70cm radios (or dual band) fitted with Anderson connector power plugs
- Antennas to match above listed radios
- HT w/ antenna, extra batteries & carrying pouch
- SAR radio & super J-pole antenna will be issued if needed for operation
- Coax as needed to meet operational antenna needs
- Masting material for each radio to include
 - Base or mounting unit
 - Stakes
 - Guy lines & anchors as needed
- Headset or earphones for each radio
- SWR bridge
- Patch cords as needed
- Assorted connectors (HF/UHF/VHF) for antenna use
- Appropriate microphones for above listed radios
- Copy of amateur radio license
- Manuals for each radio
